6.0 ACTION ITEMS

Proposed transfer of territory from Scotts Valley Unified School District to Loma Prieta Joint Union Elementary School District and Los Gatos-Saratoga Joint Union High School District (Old Santa Cruz Highway Transfer).

6.1 California Enviormental Quality Act (CEQA) Exemption

Devon Lincoln, attorney, Lozano Smith Attorneys at Law, recommended that the Board exempt this transfer from the CEQA requirement because of the extremely limited impact that the transfer would have on traffic and the environment.

6.2 Old Santa Cruz Highway Territory Transfer Proposal Feasibility Study

Ms. Lincoln advised the Board that there are nine criteria items that the California Education Code requires that the Board analyze in determining the suitability of the territory transfer. In order for the Board to approve the property transfer, the Board would have to find that all nine criteria items have been met.

Ms. Lincoln advised the Board that she and the COE staff recommend that the Board find that Criteria Item number 2 and Criteria Item number 8 have not been met.
